

2020 Adrian Flux British FIM Speedway Grand Prix, Principality Stadium, Cardiff Ticket Terms and Conditions

1. The "Organiser" is BSI Speedway Limited, a company incorporated in England and Wales and with registered offices at Building 6, Chiswick Park, 566 Chiswick High Road, Chiswick, London, W4 5HR.
2. By purchasing the ticket and/or attending the event using the ticket, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
3. This ticket is a revocable license that only grants entry into the venue of the event. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse admission to any ticket holder and may on occasion conduct security searches to ensure the safety of spectators. The Organiser shall also be entitled to remove anyone from the venue who is under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or who, in the reasonable opinion of the Organiser, is conducting themselves in an inappropriate manner or who is in breach of any other policies put in place by the Organiser. No refund or other remedy will be provided if the ticket holder is ejected or refused entry due to such conduct or for failure to comply with these ticket terms or any relevant policies prior to or following entry.
4. Tickets shall not be resold, exchanged, or transferred. To do so, or to alter or deface any ticket, will render it void. Ticket prices are subject to change without notice at any time prior to purchase.
5. It is the ticket holder's responsibility to check their ticket, as mistakes cannot always be rectified, and the Organiser shall not be responsible for any lost, stolen or counterfeit tickets. All tickets are security printed and should only be purchased direct from an official ticket agency appointed by the Organiser. Any attempt to present any other ticket will lead to refusal of admission and possible prosecution. Unauthorised vendors will be prosecuted. By submitting an order for tickets the ticket purchaser acknowledges and accepts that all details provided to the ticket issuer are correct and consent to the ticket issuer providing e-tickets immediately following processing of payment.
6. Tickets shall not be used as prizes in competitions without the prior written consent of the Organiser.
7. All sound and moving or still picture rights in connection with the event, including without limitation television programme, film, video or internet broadcast rights, vest exclusively with the Organiser and any material filmed or recorded at the event may only be used for the personal, non-profit making enjoyment of the ticket holder. By entering the venue, the ticket holder may reasonably expect (i) to be photographed, filmed or recorded as a visitor attending the Event (by the Organiser and its sponsors, licensees, advertisers and/or broadcasters); and (ii) the Organiser and its respective designees to use his or her voice, image, and/or likeness in any and all media now or hereafter existing in connection with all or any part of the Event, for any purpose whatsoever, including the commercial purposes of the Organiser, its respective sponsors, licensees, advertisers and/or broadcasters, without compensation. Ticket holders agree to adhere to any policies relating to mobile phone, camera and drone usage put in place by the Organiser.
8. Tickets are non-refundable and are sold subject to the Organiser's right to alter or vary the programme due to events or circumstances beyond its control without being obliged to refund monies or exchange tickets. It is the responsibility of the ticket holder to ascertain the date, time and venue of any rearranged staging of the event.
9. Should the event be postponed no refund of the ticket price or any additional expenditure shall be made to the ticket holder.
10. Should the event be cancelled the ticket holder shall be entitled to a full refund of the ticket price but no refund will be given in respect of any other expenditure whatsoever. All claims for ticket refunds must be made no later than thirty (30) days following the conclusion of the event by contacting speedway@img.com or 0208 233 5000, after which point no refunds will be offered. Details of how to claim refunds, exchanges or future discounts will be provided by the organisers on the day and /or on the event website.
11. In accordance with the FIM Speedway World Championship Grand Prix Regulations (the "FIM Regulations"), the race points scored at the completion of heat 16 will be sufficient to determine the result. Should the event be interrupted after the completion of heat 16, no refund of the ticket price or any other expenditure shall be made to the ticket holder. Should the FIM Regulations change

regarding completion of a meeting, the new FIM Regulations shall apply for the determination of any ticket refund. Any refunds are for the relevant portion of the ticket price paid by the ticketholder (including booking/transaction fee) as set out above, and no refund will be given in respect of any other expenditure whatsoever (including, but not limited to, travel and accommodation).

12. The ticket holder acknowledges that motorcycle racing is an inherently dangerous sport, and that unavoidable accidents can happen, personal property can be lost, stolen or damaged and injuries can be sustained (including, without limitation, as a result of noise levels surface spray, from the track, moving vehicles and flying debris or the Venue and its surrounds being uneven, sloping and slippery). Particular care should be taken when moving around the venue, particularly when near any vehicles, in large crowds or on particularly uneven, sloping or slippery areas. Care should also be taken around any temporary structure and cabling. All visitors also acknowledge the risks associated with motor racing and should follow the instructions of the Organiser at all time. In respect of these risks the ticket holder acknowledges and agrees that his or her attendance at the event is entirely at his or her own risk and hereby waives any and all claims or potential claims arising from such risks, damage or injuries. The Organiser, its employees, contractors or agents will not be liable for any loss, injury or damage howsoever caused to the bearer of the ticket save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organiser, its employees, contractors or agents or any other liability that cannot be excluded or limited under applicable laws, including the Consumer Rights Act 2015.

13. Further, the Organiser's, its employee's, contractor's or agent's liability for any breach of any term of any ticket purchased shall not exceed the face value of the ticket. In no event shall the Organiser, its employees, contractors or agents be liable for any special, consequential, incidental, indirect or exemplary damages of any kind, including, without limitation, any amount paid in excess of face value to a third party for this ticket.

14. Ticket purchasers' statutory rights as consumers in connection with their purchase of tickets through the event website are not affected by these terms and conditions. 15. The ticket is issued subject to, and these conditions incorporate, the rules and regulations of the venue at which the event is staged (which are available at www.principalitystadium.wales) and shall remain the property of the Organiser who shall have the right to recall any ticket at any time.


16. You consent to the Organiser sending you in advance of the event via email information regarding timings, travel and any other useful pre-event details. In the event of any inconsistency between the terms of this ticket and the rules and regulations of the Venue, the terms of this ticket shall prevail to the extent of any such inconsistency.

17. These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law. Disputes arising hereunder shall be subject to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts. To the extent permitted in law, any cause of action a ticket holder may have with respect to their tickets must be commenced within one year after the claim or cause of action arises.

18. If any of these terms and conditions should be determined to be illegal, invalid or otherwise unenforceable by reason of the law of any state or country in which these terms and conditions are intended to be effective, then to the extent and within the jurisdiction in which that term or condition is illegal, invalid or unenforceable, it shall be severed and deleted from that term and the remaining terms and conditions shall survive and continue to be binding and enforceable.

In addition to the terms set out above, the following terms apply only to ticket holders who have purchased coach tickets as part of their order:

1. Only ticket holders who have included and paid for a coach ticket are permitted to utilise the coach services to and from the Event.
2. Coach tickets will be for use only on a specific route and at specific times, as indicated at the time of purchase and on the confirmation email issued to the ticket holder (but subject to change at the Organiser's discretion, including the right to combine routes (between a maximum of three departure points)).

3. No pick ups or drop offs will be made will be made at any location other than those stated on the confirmation email.
4. Ticket holders are responsible for getting to the location of departure at the time indicated on their confirmation email, or as otherwise notified to them by the Organiser or Coach Operator. In the event that a ticket holder is not at the relevant location at the stated time no refunds will be issued for the missed journey.
5. Ticket holders will be permitted to bring one item of luggage to be stowed in the undercarriage of the coach, and a further item of handheld luggage to come on board the coach. All luggage or other personal items brought onto the coach is at the ticket holder's sole risk. Property found in a coach will not be treated as belonging to the person who finds it and must be handed over as soon as reasonably possible to the Organiser, coach operator or the Organiser's representatives or agents. Whilst the Organiser or the Organiser's representatives or agents will use reasonable endeavours to locate the owner of any lost property, if within three months such property has not been retrieved it will be sold or otherwise disposed of.
6. Ticket holders will be permitted to bring their own food and drink on board the coaches, however, no alcohol may be consumed on board in any circumstances.
7. Coach tickets will only be refunded to ticket holders in the following circumstances:
 - a. If the Event is cancelled in its entirety prior to the date of the Event;
 - b. If the relevant coach journey is cancelled prior to departure; and/or
 - c. If, as a result of a delay in your coach journey, you are prevented from attending the Event in its entirety.
8. If, as a result of a delay in your coach journey, you miss a proportion of the Event, you will be entitled to receive a refund of your Event ticket price proportionate to the number of heats missed.
9. Ticket holders must look after their confirmation email and present it for inspection when asked by a member of staff. Failure to produce the confirmation email will result in removal from the relevant service or the charging of a penalty fare.
10. Ticket Holders are responsible for getting to the departure location after the Event at the scheduled departure time and are responsible for getting on the correct coach to the destination stated on their confirmation email. The coaches will not wait after the scheduled departure time for any late passengers, and the coach operator and Organiser are not liable for any form of compensation or payment for getting the late ticket holder to their destination.
11. Ticket holders should at all times show consideration for other passengers so that everyone is able to have an enjoyable travel experience to the Event. Anti-social, criminal or abusive behaviour affects other passengers and could result in the ticket holder's removal from the service without refund.
12. In accordance with point 12 of the main terms above, the ticket holder acknowledges that his or her use of the coach service is entirely at his or her own risk and hereby waives any and all claims or potential claims arising from any damage or loss to personal property or injuries sustained whilst using the coach service, save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organiser, its employees, contractors or agents.
