DATA PRIVACY: Your personal data will be processed and stored in the United Kingdom by the Controller, BSI Speedway Limited, of 566 Chiswick High Road, London W4 5HR, for the purposes of administering the Competition, notification of winning contestants and awarding prizes. We collect personal information you give us such as your name, address, social media account details and e-mail address for this purpose. We may also collect information about you if you register for an account or contest via a social media platform including Facebook, Twitter and Google+. Definitions:

 - b. Upload a video of you (or your group) performing your talent / skill; and
 - c. enter your name(s), countr(ies) of residence, email(s) and other details.

All qualifying entries will be assessed by the Promoter, who will determine the winner based on the best and most suitable qualifying entry (in the Promoter's sole discretion) within 14 days of the closing date set out in point 1 above at the Promoter's offices in London (the "**Prize Winner**"). The Prize Winner will be notified via the contact details provided at the time of entry to the Competition. The Prize Winner (if a Prize Winner is chosen) will be given the opportunity to perform during the 2020 Adrian Flux British FIM Speedway Grand Prix (and receive 2x free general admission tickets to the meeting (per member of the group if applicable)).
